


HIKING

INFORMATION



Across the Catalonian part of the Pyrénées Méditerranée, there is a vast range of hiking trails suitable for all levels in this fantastic natural environment. There are 1,860 kilometres of waymarked hiking trails, a preserved natural environment with the Canigó Massif - Grand Site de France, the Pyrénées-Catalanes Regional Natural Park and the Marine Natural Park of the Gulf of Lion. Added to that, 9 natural reserves and the very first marine reserve in France (created in 1974), the Catalonian part of the Pyrénées Méditerranée is a reference for the preservation of biodiversity. The Hiking maps from the ADT of the Pyrénées-Orientales features walks of varying distance, as well as more sporty hikes across the local area and the whole department.

Our department also boasts some of the long 'GR' hiking trails for hikes over several days. You can cross the Pyrenees along the GR10, go around the Pérics mountains from one refuge to the next, set off on the Tour du Canigó to the very core of the Catalan soul, hike around the highest Catalan peak, the Capcir, the wild Pyrenees.
